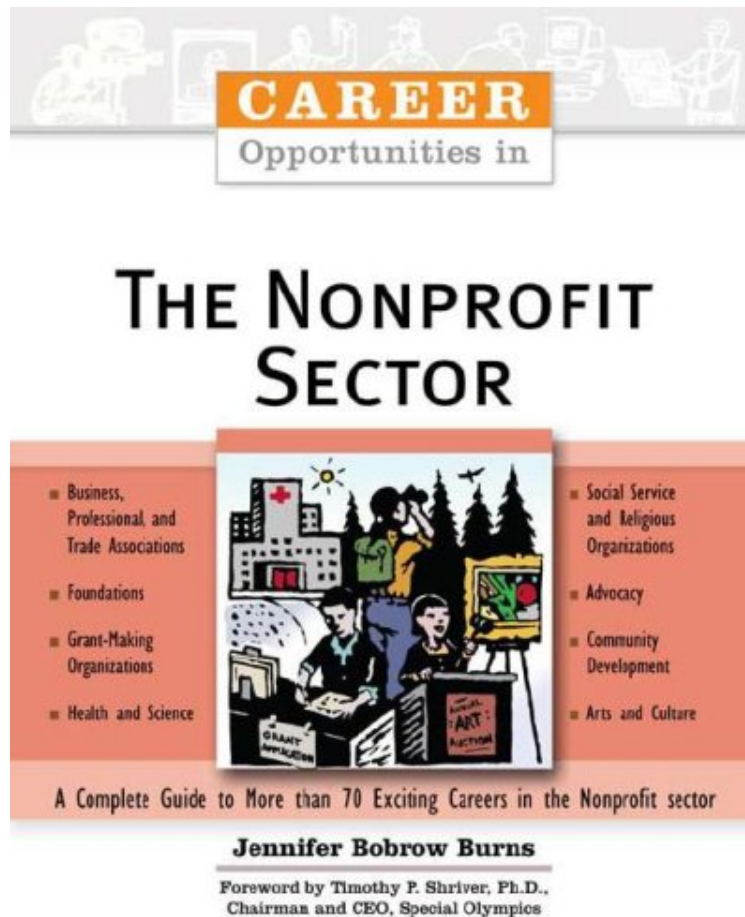

It gives detailed job descriptions of just about every position available, along with employment prospects (somewhat inflated) and advancement prospects. Each position also included a career ladder, showing what positions are normally held prior to a job and what positions you can advance to from a position. The career ladder is not something included in many career guides, so I found it quite useful. There are also several valuable appendices, including websites to find jobs and a list of the 100 largest nonprofits in the US. Explaining what jobs are typically available, and the skills and experience needed. It is

written mostly for those with no or little experience. Possibly for students in high school or university contemplating a career choice. The fields covered are quite varied. And the chapters have links to useful websites with more information.

Approximately 13 million Americans are currently employed in the nonprofit sector, and the Bureau of Labor Statistics predicts a 10-percent increase by 2010. Representing more than 10 different industries and hundreds of job functions, more than 70 careers in the nonprofit sector abound for those skilled in research, writing, mathematics, and more. Extensive appendixes include lists of schools, organizations, publications, and further resources. Career profiles include: Bioresource engineer, Development assistant, Executive director, Grant writer, Health policy analyst, International aid worker, Lobbyist, Program director, and more.
